SUBJECT: EDINA HIGH SCHOOL/VALLEY VIEW MIDDLE SCHOOL
CEILING PANELINGS

Be It Resolved, That

The Board of Education

Award a contract to Acoustics Associates in the amount of \$25,350 for furnishing and installing ceiling panels at Edina High School and Valley View Middle School.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION

As part of the solution to remedy the paneling situation at Valley View Middle School and Edina High School, the administration has received a quotation from Acoustics Associates to furnish and install black fabric wrapped fiberglass panels in the ceilings at the main entrance of the High School, the EPAC entrance at the High School, and the main entrance at Valley View Middle School. Our architect, Ted Rozeboom, recommends this product, thinks that the cost is reasonable, and does not think that the installation of these panels will impair any future plans for different wall paneling. The panels will be installed into existing grids previously installed by Acoustics Associates; thus the lack of a quotation from a second vendor. The administration and School Board members Randy Meyer and Peyton Robb recommend the awarding of the contract to Acoustics Association. The cost will initially come from the Capital Budget, although reimbursement will be sought from Prodema, the manufacturer of the original panels.
