



Normandale Outerwear Apparel Guidelines

When students go outdoors:

Grades K – 2

- If temperatures are below 40° students must have long sleeves or a jacket.
- If accumulated snow is present or the ground is very wet students must wear boots* and snow pants (if students don't have boots they will be restricted to designated areas that are less wet).
- When temperatures are below 10° students must wear hats and mittens.

Grades 3 – 5

- If temperatures are below 40° students must have long sleeves or a jacket.
- If accumulated snow is present or the ground is very wet students should wear boots* (if students don't have boots they will be restricted to designated areas that are less wet).
- When temperatures are below 10° students must wear hats and mittens.

*If students wear Chuggs or some other kind of boot indoors, they must have outdoor boots as well. Inversely, students are not allowed to wear outdoor boots in the classroom. It is a good practice to send an extra pair of shoes that can be kept at school during the winter months.
